#### SOUTH AFRICAN HOLIDAYS:

#### PASSPORT & VISA:

Make sure to check that your passport is valid and that you are aware of the visa requirements for your visit to South Africa. ### MEDICAL AID & TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Insure you are well covered when travelling should a medical emergency occur or theft of your luggage. Rather be over prepared than not prepared at all.

#### TRANSPORT:

Make sure you pack your international license on your trip should you wish to rent a vehicle. Remember, in South Africa, we drive on the left side of the road. Their are various transport options available, but make sure it is reliable by searching for them on the web. Major cities have Uber available but smaller towns don't. Travel destinations usually have quite a few shuttle/transfer options available that can even arrange excursions.

#### MONEY:

It is always good to arrive with some ZAR but make sure to not carry large amounts in crowded places. Also, hide cash in multiple locations in your luggage. The safest way to purchase items is with a credit card. Keep cash for tourist attraction vendors as they don't have card facilities.

#### LANGUAGE:

Most people in South Africa are fluent in English so no need to learn Zulu/Shangaan if you are a foreigner. South Africa has 11 official languages... We are very friendly so don't be afraid to ask for directions or help.

#### VALUABLES:

Make sure to store valuables when you go on excursions. Petty crime happens sporadically at high density tourist places. Be vigilant and hold on to your valuables/handbag.

### WHAT TO PACK?

#### CLOTHING:

Check weather forecasts before you visit the lodge and pack accordingly. Bring comfortable shoes if you are interested in joining us on one of our bush walks.

#### SUN PROTECTION:

It is advisable to pack a hat to protect against sun damage when outside for long periods of time. A good SPF product is also recommended especially for the the pool lovers.

#### MOSQUITO REPELLENT:

Mbbavala Lodge is located in a Malaria area. Please consult your GP before taking any prophylactics against Malaria. You are welcome to pack extra repellant to keep mozzies at bay or buy in town - suggested brands are Peaceful Sleep / Tabard.

#### ELECTRONICS:

Remember your international adapter if you are visiting us from outside South Africa. Photographers should pack cameras and chargers as there is ample opportunity to take gorgeous pictures.. There is enough outlets around the lodge to charge all your electronics.

#### SWIMMING TOWELS:

Bring an extra swimming towel. Towels in the rooms are only for bathing purposes.
